Pharmacists are authorized to give the flu shot in all 50 states

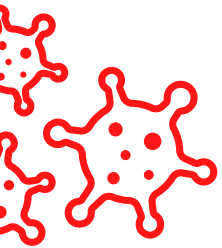
KEEP HEALTHY PEOPLE WELL AND DOCTORS FOCUSED ON TREATING PATIENTS
